DEFINITION:

Under listed supervision of Animal Caretaker, a student performs all or part of the following duties:

- (a) Maintains a regular schedule, including weekend day and holiday availability.
- (b) Ability to work independently.
- (c) Responsible in weighing food for the animals.
- (d) Provides emergency care to animals.
- (e) Maintains specified diets and exercise of animals.
- (f) Records whatever data is necessary for research on behavior of each animal.
- (g) Maintains necessary and prescribed environment of research animals:
 - washing cages
 - change of bedding
 - prevention of contamination from outside animals
 - research areas are to be kept vermin-free
- (h) Loads and unloads bags of feed.
- (i) Performs related duties as assigned.

BASIC QUALIFICATIONS:

One year of experience at care of animals in either professional setting or in a laboratory. Student worker will be trained in the performance of the above duties.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR STARTING AT STEP B:

Two years of experience at care of animals in a professional setting or in a laboratory.
