DEFINITION:

Under close supervision of the Head of Assistant Athletic Trainer, a student usually performs all or part of the following duties:

- (a) Participates in Athletic Training (AT) coverage for physicals, practice and competition situations for the various sport seasons.
- (b) Assists in the preparation of Training Room (TR) i.e., set up of supplies, daily and seasonal cleaning and duties necessary to provide a clean organized environment for home and visiting athletes and other students enrolled in AT classes
- (c) Assists in record keeping, injury treatment, and rehabilitation logs, maintenance and organization of library and other AT information.
- (d) Assists in inventory control and record keeping as necessary.
- (e) Provides first aid treatment for athletic injuries.
- (f) Assists in planning and implementation of rehabilitation programs, post-injury or surgical intervention.
- (g) Assists in In-Service presentations, physician visits and other special situations as directed by the Head Trainer.

BASIC QUALIFICATIONS:

Be enrolled in or have successfully completed Athletic Training curriculum, PE331 or PE336. Be CPR and Advanced First Aid Certified.
