DEFINITION:

Under the limited supervision of a staff or faculty employee, a student usually performs the following duties:

- (a) Assists in training and supervising Audio-Visual Technician II.
- (b) Repairs, checks, adjust, and cleans all types of audio-visual equipment.
- (c) Observes video signals during television productions, making changes in gain controls for optimum video signal as required.
- (d) Assists in designing audio and/or visual installations to achieve acoustical effects, screen placement, etc.

BASIC QUALIFICATIONS:

One academic year (two semesters) as a Audio-Visual Technician II and at least six months experience in the repair of electronic and/or mechanical audio-visual equipment, or one year comparable experience outside UIC.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR STARTING AT STEP B:

Same as above plus an additional year of comparable experience.
