DEFINITION:

Under the direction of a staff or faculty employee, a student usually performs all or part of the following duties:

- (a) Prepares computer programs.
- (b) Implements defined revisions to existing computer programs.
- (c) Prepares and uses test data to insure proper program performance.

BASIC QUALIFICATIONS:

Must be a graduate student. Introduction and intermediate courses in a computer technology and one year experience as a Computer Production Control Aide, or an equivalent combination of course work and experience which suggests a potential for good performance.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR STARTING AT STEP B:

Introductory and intermediate courses in computer technology and two years as a Computer Production Control Aide, or an equivalent combination of course work and experience.
