DEFINITION:

Under limited supervision of a staff or faculty employee, a student performs all or part of the following duties:

- (a) Supervises and trains laboratory aides.
- (b) Reviews and evaluates work of laboratory aides.
- (c) Performs standard technical procedures such as staining, evaporating, measuring materials, compounding, centrifuging, titrating and filtering.
- (d) Performs autopsies, noting any abnormalities.
- (e) Creates video, audio, photo, and pencil sketches.
- (f) Adjust, calibrates, replaces broken parts, and generally keeps a wide variety of laboratory equipment in good repair.

BASIC QUALIFICATIONS:

Two (2) academic years (four semesters) as a laboratory aide and advanced courses in the discipline involved or comparable experience.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR STARTING AT STEP B:

Three (3) academic years (six semesters) as a laboratory aide and advanced courses in the discipline involved or comparable experience.
