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## **DEFINITION**:

Under the limited supervision of a staff or faculty employee, a student usually performs all or part of the following duties:

- (a) Assists the instructor by leading discussion groups or providing guidance and instruction on technical skills in the laboratory.
- (b) Evaluates homework assignments and exams.
- (c) Administers examinations.

## **BASIC QUALIFICATIONS:**

Progression to at least the fourth year in the academic field relating to the work to be performed <u>or</u> at least three (3) years of work experience or training in the discipline relating to the work to be performed.

## QUALIFICATIONS FOR STARTING AT STEP B:

Additional year of related work experience or training in the discipline relating to the work to be performed.

- Manage technology to integrate information to support relevant, effective, and timely decision-making.
