**DEFINITION:**

Under supervision of a Manager/Supervisor, a student usually performs the following duties:

- (a) Operates as a television camera person and studio floor director.
- (b) Helps construct and arrange sets and props in the studio.
- (c) Aids in storing and cataloging sets and props.
- (d) Supports al tasks related to television maintenance.
- (e) Organizes sets, lights, and sound equipment for television productions.

None. However, the student should be interested in technical aspects related to the performing arts or be enrolled in related courses.
